



Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander households can receive a rebate of \$330 on their electricity.

Do you need support to pay for your electricity bill?

You could be eligible for the Queensland Government Electricity Rebate to assist with your electricity costs.

To be eligible, you must hold one of the following cards:

- Pensioner Concession Card
- Queensland Seniors Card
- Department of Veterans' Affairs Gold Card
- Health Care Card*

The Electricity Rebate is automatically deducted from your monthly or quarterly electricity bill.

Only **one person** per household can receive the rebate.

To find out if you're eligible, call your electricity retailer today. You can find their number on your electricity bill.

* Health Care Card holders can contact their electricity retailer to apply for the concession after 1 April 2017.

The concession will be back-dated to 1 January 2017 depending on eligibility.
